

## **1** Day excursion - Energy in the Basel Region.



It is not easy for consumers to differentiate products in the energy sector. After all, a KhW of electricity whether it is produced from a renewable source or a diesel generator will feel just the same to a toddler sticking his finger in an electrical socket! Yet, environmental concerns (i.e. climate change, biodiversity) and geopolitical crises (i.e. war in Ukraine) forced us, the consumers, to think about how and where the energy we consume comes from.
